Due to rising cost of food and requirements from the Ohio Department of Education, Ironton City Schools Food Service Department have made some changes to our food service meal pricing. This will affect adult meals and a la carte meals (extra items) for students and adults. We have made a tremendous effort to keep prices down over the years, but we all realize that the cost to purchase goods is increasing at a torrid pace. Adult meal prices will remain the same but adult breakfast will be \$2.50. Extra entree (adult or student) will be \$1.25 for breakfast and \$1.50 for lunch. Fortunately, there are no changes to the basic free student breakfast and lunch as offered over the past several years. A breakdown of additional increases can be found in the cafeteria with the head cook and on tigertown.com under the "Department>Cafeteria" tab.
